Note: Unless one of the above mentioned is satisfied upon arrival, new students will take English Language Placement Exam (ELPE). The passing score is 80. Students who pass ELPE are allocated to the programme of study, otherwise to English Preparatory Programme for a semester or a year.

Arkin University of Creative Arts & Design (ARUCAD) provides our students with an STUDIO style comfortable accommodation option.
