Full Admission to Avila Nursing

- 60 transferable credits with at least a 2.8 GPA
- Completion of these prerequisite courses with a minimum GPA of 2.5:
 - Anatomy and Physiology I
 - Anatomy and Physiology II
 - Chemistry
 - Microbiology
 - Statistics
 - Developmental Psychology
 - Pathophysiology
- Meet core general education requirements
 - Applicants who have earned an associate or bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university will have fulfilled all general education requirements.
 - Applicants who have yet to complete all general education credits can take these classes in an online accelerated format and will work with an academic advisor to complete a personalized degree completion plan.
- TEAS score of 70%

Students admitted must also meet the following requirements to participate in nursing clinical courses:

- Meet immunization and health screening requirements
- Complete a criminal background check and drug screening

- Hold a current certification in a basic cardiac life support (BCLS) healthcare provider course
- Submit annual tuberculosis (TB) skin test results
- Carry your own health insurance coverage and provide a health insurance form reflecting the company and coverage to be kept on file in the Avila School of Nursing office

Accommodation

Avila's residence halls are on campus and open all year, including holidays. Living on campus gives you easy access to your classrooms, the library, and computer labs.
