You must take the original entry qualification documents along with you when you finally go to the university.

UTA accepts the following English language certificate (B1 level equivalent) such as TOEFL, TOEIC, IELTS, FCE, ESOL, IESOL, SET, EBC, EOS, LCCI, CAE, CPE, BEC, CEIBT, CELS.

A relevant portfolio is required.

The portfolio should consist of between 5 and 10 works in at least A3 format, made in pencil, including:

- 3 drawings representing architecture,
- 2 drawings representing compositions of simple geometric shapes, equipment, and textiles.

The portfolio should be accompanied by a statement that the work submitted was produced independently (available under the link that Admissions Team will send to upload portfolio).

The works will be assessed by the admissions committee on their ability to use perspective, observation of chiaroscuro, proportion, and detail.
