- Goethe Certificate C1 or C2 (minimum grade 2)



- telc C1 or C2 (minimum grade 2)
- telc C1 Hochschule
- Language diploma (Level II) of the Conference of Ministers of Education (KMK), also called DSD II
- Assessment test of a Studienkolleg, German language part

- General university entrance qualification or advanced technical college entrance qualification (if you do not yet have a certificate, the latest interim report is sufficient)
