Requirements

- A 2(II) or higher single or joint honours degree is required, or equivalent overseas qualification and grade. Alternatively, possession of a suitable professional qualification and practical experience may also be accepted.
The programme is not suitable for applicants who have studied data analytics or computer science at Bachelor level.
- Candidates without a relevant degree or professional qualification should have a minimum of three years work experience in a relevant setting and with a substantial level of responsibility.

If English is not your native language, then satisfactory evidence of written and spoken English must be provided:

- IELTS: 6.0 (with no element below 5.5)
- Pearson PTE: a score of 56 (with no element lower than 51)
- Cambridge English Test – Advanced: 169 (with no element lower than 162)
